Mrs. Hernandez read the following Legal Notice that appeared in the Bluefield Daily Telegraph on Wednesday, July 29, 2020 and Wednesday, August 5, 2020.

The Council of the Town of Bluefield, Virginia will hold a public hearing on the proposed issuance of a bond by the Town of Bluefield. The estimated maximum amount of the bond to be issued is \$1,000,000.00. The proposed use of the proceeds of the bond is to pay for the costs of capital improvements to the Town's municipal golf course. The public hearing which may be continued or adjourned, and at which persons may appear and present their views on the proposed bond issue will be held at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on August 11, 2020, before the Council of the Town of Bluefield, Virginia in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall located at 112 Huffard Drive, Bluefield, Virginia.
